Taylor pointed out that both he and Cllr. Chapman were Trustees of the Village Hall, as was the applicant of PA17/00871 but it was not felt that this was a disclosable interest that should exclude them from the discussion of that application.

PL3/2017	Planning Applications –
	a. PA17/00871, Port Blakes, Fore Street, Grampound – replacement of a garage / studio with a 2-storey, 1-bedroom studio home, with garage, shower room, kitchen/dining and lounge. The committee had queries relating to aspects of the application. Nonetheless, the committee felt that the demolition of the derelict shed and replacement with the garage and studio flat would be an improvement to the village. However it was also felt that the objection registered by a neighbour had some merit. As neither the applicant nor the objector were in attendance, it was not possible to clarify the relevant weight which should be applied to the arguments. The committee decided that we could neither support nor object to the proposal and agreed to allow the application to proceed without comment.
	b. PA17/00194/PREAPP, The Limes, Grampound – pre-application advice to conserve and interpret the remains of The Limes which formed part of the famous Manor Tannery. Noted
