PL15/2017	Planning Applications –	
	a. PA17/09307, Land and Garages E of Ashwood House, Grampound – erection of new dwelling. Councillors felt that this was a poorly presented application, with many deficiencies and inaccuracies. The layout of the building and area were different between the application and the plans. There was concern about access to and from the main highway, lack of parking provision in an already busy lane with no available parking spaces, a tree in a preservation area was shown as being removed, a soakaway was shown as being above a known spring. It was noted that there would be loss of light and privacy for several neighbouring properties. The proposed development is not in keeping with the character of the lane and we therefore OBJECT to the proposal.	Clerk
