PL18/2017	Planning Applications –		
	a. PA17/10578, Rear of Mill Lane Surgery, Mill Lane, Grampound – proposed new two-bedroom detached dwelling and domestic garage. The application is seeking to bring into use a derelict building and disused portion of land next to the river. The proposals included parking space and retained a modest portion of recreational land surrounding the development. Mill Lane properties are already of a wide variety of styles and the development is not therefore likely to clash with other properties in the area. Some concern was expressed regarding the potential flood risk, though this is no more serious than other properties in the vicinity. It was therefore decided to SUPPORT the application.	Clerk	
	b. PA17/11154, 17 Bonython Drive, Grampound – proposed entrance porch and Utility Room. There was some surprise that these proposals required planning permission as both the porch and the extension at the back appear to be permitted developments. However, for the same reason, there were no objections to the proposals, so the application was SUPPORTED.	Clerk
