	NOTE – Mr David McLaughan, Gateley Smithers Purslow advised that providing the draft Schedule of Works is approved and sent out for tender by 31st March 2023 with a 3 week return period, we would anticipate a potential start on site date of 15th May 2023. With a works programme of say 8-10 weeks to effectively complete all the structural repairs this gives a completion of between 10th to 24th July 2023.	
	b. Proposed Flowering Trees, Fore Street – Cllrs. McGuinness and Taylor had met i.r.o. the potential commemorative tree locations. Cllr McGuinness will prepare a brief information sheet suggesting three tree types for two verge locations (in planting bed) on the south side of Fore Street either side of the car park entrance.
